AGIA is represented on the Australian Geoscience Council, with a role to provide advice and comments on geoscience-related matters to academia, government, and industry groups.

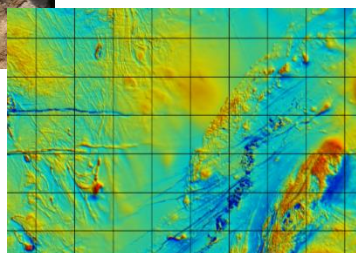


ACTIVITIES
